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## ABOUT SUDOKU

Sudoku is a popular puzzle game that originated in Japan. It is based on logic and pattern recognition. You don't need any math skills to play—just careful thinking and concentration.

## HOW TO PLAY SUDOKU

The goal of Sudoku is to fill a  $9 \times 9$  grid with numbers so that each row, column, and  $3 \times 3$  box contains all the digits from 1 to 9.

At the start of the game, some numbers are already filled in. Your task is to use logic to complete the grid.

A move is incorrect if:

- A row contains the same number more than once
- A column contains the same number more than once
- A  $3 \times 3$  box contains the same number more than once

## SUDOKU TIPS

Here are a few Sudoku tips that you can use to improve your Sudoku skills.

### Tip 1:

Look for rows, columns, or 3×3 boxes that already contain 5 or more numbers. Focus on the empty cells and try the numbers that are missing. Often, you'll find that only one number can fit in a particular spot.

### Tip 2:

Divide the grid visually into three rows and three columns of larger boxes. Look for a number that appears twice within a row or column of boxes. This can help you figure out where the missing number must go in the remaining box.

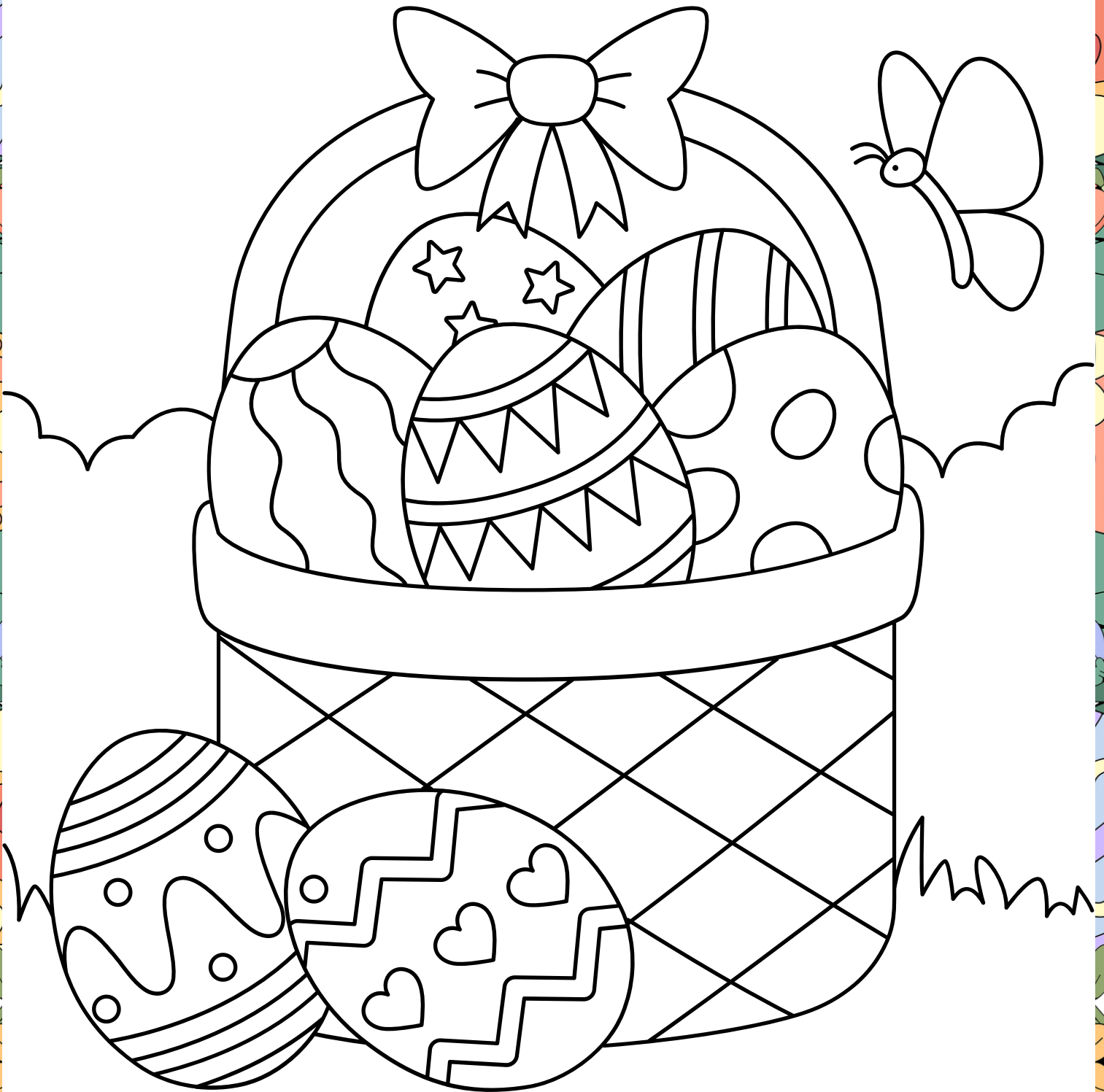
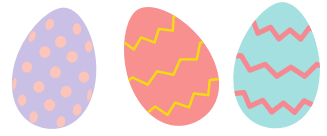
