MEDUSA



Medusa is a prominent figure in Greek mythology, often depicted as a monstrous Gorgon with snakes for hair and the ability to turn anyone who gazes upon her into stone. She was one of three Gorgon sisters, with the others being Stheno and Euryale. Medusa's fate was sealed when she incurred the wrath of the goddess Athena, who transformed her into the feared creature. She later met her demise at the hands of the hero Perseus, who beheaded her using a reflective shield to avoid her petrifying gaze. Medusa's story remains a symbol of both terror and vulnerability in Greek mythology, and her visage continues to captivate and intrigue people to this day.
